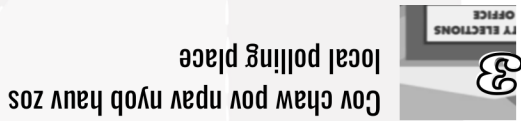

Yuav qhib tau kev rau tib neeg tuaj twv txiaj tim ntsej tim muag rau tej chaw uas ib txwm tsis muaj li ntawm tej chaw tso nees khiav thiab cov tsev twv txiaj uas yog tsoom fww tso cai rau cov pab pawg Native American Tribes. Thiab yuav qhib tau kev rau ntau yam kev twv txiaj rau tej chaw uas yog tuav los ntawm cov tribal casinos. Allows in-person sports betting at designated horse racetracks and at casinos operated by federally recognized Native American tribes. Also allows additional kinds of gambling at tribal casinos.

Tso cai rau Haiv Neeg Native American uas muaj ntawv tso cai thiab cov lag luam twv txiaj txawv xeev los mus qhib kev sib twv tso nyiaj online rau cov neeg muaj 21 xyoos rov saud. Yog dhau, cov tribes uas muaj ntaub ntawv tso cai yuav tau pub cov lag luam tuam txhab loj los mus tswj kev twv txiaj online. Qhov no kuj qhib tau hww tsam rau cov me nyuam yau los mus nkag twv txiaj tau saum online. Allows licensed Native American tribes and gambling companies to offer online sports betting. If passed, licensed tribes must give up some of their rights under federal law. It also increases the chance that minors would have access to online betting.

Nce nqi them se txiaj tawm ntawm nyiaj hli uas yog los ntawm cov neeg muaj nyiaj tshaj \$2 million los pab txhawb cov tsheb uas yog zero-emission thiab pab rau cov chaw tua hluav taws thiab programs uas pab cob qhia txog kev hluav taws. Increases tax on personal income above \$2 million to fund zero-emission vehicle and wildfire prevention programs.
