Kev xaiv tsa txog nrab, uas yog midterms, muaj tshwm sim rau thaum txog nrab rau U.S. tus president lossis thawj Tswj Hwm teb chaws lub sij hawm los kav, txog nrab yog xyoo ob ntawm plaub xyoos los nyob ua lub luag hauj lwm. Cov neeg nyob ua hauj lwm rau House of Representatives raug xaiv txhua ob xyoos hos cov khiav dej num rau Senate raug xaiv txhua rau xyoo. Txoj kev xaiv tsa yuav muaj feem cuam tshuam txog tus neeg nyob rau Congress thiab cov cai uas yuav muaj txiav txim txaus ntxiv.

Nyob rau lub 11 Hlis Ntuj, cov neeg hauv California yuav mus xaiv tsa cov nom tswv rau theem state thiab cov nyob hauv zos los mus saib xyuas thiab txiav txim txog tej xwm txheej uas muaj feem rau peb lub zej zog. Cov neeg xaiv tsa kuj yuav tau los tawm suab txog cov cai nyob rau daim ntawv xaiv tsa uas muaj feem cuam tshuam txog peb lub neej kev noj haus.

Peb los pov npav rau nrab xyoo midterms vim nws yog peb txoj cai los mus siv peb lub suab thiab lub dag zog los xaiv tsa cov thawj coj uas yuav los xub pub rau peb lub zej zog. Qhov tuaj tshwm rau ntawm chaw xaiv tsa lub 11 Hlis Ntuj Hnub Tim 8, peb yuav tuaj ntsuam xyuas tias peb yeej muaj txoj cai los tawm suab rau peb lub xeev thiab lub teb chaws tias nws yuav tswj hwm peb li cas.

Midterm elections, or midterms, are held in the middle of a U.S. Presidential term, during the second year of a president's four-year period in office. Members of the House of Representatives are elected every two years while members of the Senate are elected every six years. The result of these elections impact who is in Congress and how laws are made.

In November, California voters will go to the polls to elect state and local leaders who will make important decisions about issues that affect our communities. Voters will also weigh in on ballot measures that impact our everyday lives.

We vote in the midterms because it is our right to use our voice and political power to elect leaders who will fight for our communities. By showing up to the polls on November 8, we ensure that we have a say in how our state and country is governed.

PROP 1: REPRODUCTIVE FREEDOM

Guarantees reproductive freedom in the California Constitution by saying that the state cannot deny or interfere with a person's right to have an abortion and use contraceptives.

The Facts

Reproductive justice is when people have the right to have children, not have children, and to parent in safe communities.

Abortions are a common medical service and a vital part of reproductive health.

Restrictions on reproductive freedom cause harm to women of color.

Vote YES on Prop 1

California leads the country in its protections for reproductive freedom, especially now that the Supreme Court overturned the federal right to have an abortion. Let's ensure that the right to abortion access and reproductive health is protected for all!

Kev ncaj ncees ntawm kev xaiv muaj me nyuam yog thaum tib neeg muaj cai los yug me nyuam, xaiv tsis yug me nyuam, thiab dhau los ua niam ua txiv rau ib lub zej zog uas muaj kev nyab xeeb.

Kev rho me nyuam yog ib yam uas tshwm sim ntau nyob rau txoj kev kho mob thiab ib qho kev tseem ceeb rau ntawm kev noj qab haus huv ntawm lub nrog cev tsev me nyuam.

California yog lub xeev uas coj lub teb chaws rau txoj kev tiv thaiv kev ywj pheej ntawm kev muaj me nyuam, tshwj xeeb tshaj rau tam sim no uas U.S. Supreme Court rov thim txoj cai uas tsoom fwv tau tsim muaj los pub rho me nyuam. PROP 26: SPORTS BETTING

Sports betting, aside from horse racing, is not currently legal in California. This proposition would allow in-person sports betting at designated horse racetracks and at casinos operated by federally recognized Native American tribes. It would also allow additional kinds of gambling at tribal casinos, like roulette and dice games like craps.

PROP 27: ONLINE GAMBLING

Tsis yog

Allows licensed Native American tribes and gambling companies to offer online sports betting. If passed, licensed tribes must give up some of their rights under federal law. It also increases the chance that minors would have access to online betting.

PROP 28: ARTS & MUSIC FUNDING

Supports additional funding for arts and music education in all K-12 public schools, including schools with high proportions of economically disadvantaged students. Directs \$1 billion per year of existing school funding for arts and music education.

PROP 28: NRHIAV NYIAJ TXIAG RAU KEV KOS DUAB THIAB KEV UA NKAUJ

Txhawb nqa kom tau nyiaj txiag pub rau kev uasi kos duab yeeb yam thiab kev ua nkauj suab paj nruag hauv cov tsev kawm ntaww K-12, nrog rau cov tsev kawm ntaww uas muaj cov me nyuam coob tu ncua kev pab. Muab \$1 billion tuaj ib xyos ncaj qha rau cov tsev kawm uas muaj cov kev qhia rau sab kev ua yeeb yam kos duab nrog rau suab paj nruag hu nkauj.

PROP 29: DIALYSIS CLINICS

Imposes new requirements on dialysis clinics related to staffing, data reporting, and anti-discrimination. This proposition would require dialysis clinics to have at least one physician, nurse practitioner, or physician assistant present while patients are being treated. It also requires that clinics report infection data to the state and prohibits clinics from refusing treatment to people based on their insurance type.

PROP 30: TAX FOR GREEN ENERGY

Increases tax on personal income above \$2 million by 1.75% to fund zero-emission vehicle subsidies, zero-emission vehicle infrastructure (such as electric vehicle charging stations), and wildfire suppression and prevention programs.

PROP 31: FLAVORED TOBACCO BAN

Upholds California legislation from 2020 to ban the sale of flavored tobacco products. This law bans flavored tobacco products—including cigarettes, e-cigarettes, vapes, and chewing tobacco—from being sold in stores and vending machines. Tobacco corporations' attempt to undo the law puts kids and teens at risk of getting access to flavored tobacco products.

PROP 31: TXWV LUAM YEEB UAS MUAJ NTXHIAB TSW

Tuav California txoj cai uas muaj tseg txij 2020 los txwv txoj kev muag cov luam yeeb uas muaj cov ntxhiab tsw. Tsab cai no txwv cov luam yeeb uas muaj ntxhiab – uas yog cov pas luam yeeb cigarettes, e-cigarettes, vapes, thiab cov luam yeeb coj los ntsuas uas yog tobacco-- txwv los muag rau hauv kiab khw thiab cov vending machines. Cov tuam txhab luam yeeb loj xav thim kom txoj cai uas yog dhau ces yuav qhib tau kev rau cov tsis muaj noob nyooog los yuav thiab nrhiau tau cov luam yeeb coj los siv.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

CAN I VOTE IN PERSON?

All California voters will receive a vote-by-mail ballot. However, you can still choose to vote in person. And if you vote in person, you can bring someone to assist you in completing your ballot. You can vote at the polls on Election Day, November 8, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. The location of your polling place is provided in your county Voter Information Guide mailed to you by your county elections official.
